## TOURNAMENT RULES

## RE-ENTRY

1. Team Events - Individuals may bowl a maximum of three times in team events. Teams may cash only one time in the team prize list with the same players, but may cash up to 3 times with a change of 2 players.
2. Singles \& Doubles - Individuals may bowl a maximum of three time in Singles/Doubles events. Bowlers may cash only once in the singles prize list. Bowlers may cash only one time in the doubles prize list with the same partner, but may cash up to 3 times with a change of partner.

## AVERAGES and HANDICAPS

3. A bowlers average is based on 21 games or more. Only winter averages are used, unless the bowler only has a summer average. Sport averages only considered if bowler has no other average. Youth league averages will be accepted.
a) Entrants will use their highest verifiable winter league average from 2022-23
b) If a bowler does not have an average from 2022-23 season, they will use their highest verifiable average, of 21 games or more, at the time of bowling.
c) If a bowler's average, as of the date of bowling, is 10 or more pins higher than their entering average the higher average will be used.
d) If a bowler doesn't meet any of the above requirements they bowl scratch (230 ave).
e) If a bowler has a 10 pin or higher current average, 21 games or more, in any competition and it is higher than their entering average, they MUST disclose this to the tournament manger (sanctioned or unsanctioned events).
4. Bowlers are individually responsible for verification of their average, even if they do not submit their average. Failure of a bowler to report their correct average by the end of the first game, of any event, may disqualify their scores. If a bowlers average is found to be higher than the reported average, the scores will be disqualified. If the incorrect average is lower than the actual average, the bowler will use the average reported at the time of bowling, which is the higher average.
5. If a bowler has only a Sport League average, their average will be adjusted using USBC Rule 201c. Indicate on the entry form if you are using a Sport league average.
6. Handicap based on $\mathbf{9 0 \%}$ of $\mathbf{2 3 0}$. The maximum handicap for team event is 1170 pins. For singles and doubles the maximum handicap is 229 pins (145 ave) for men and 297 pins (120) for ladies.
7. Team Events - Male bowlers with a USBC sanctioned league average of less than 145 will be entered with an average of 145 .
8. All bowlers who have qualified for a prize of $\$ 600$ or more in any tournament within the previous 12 month period must report their actual score, position and amount won. This will be used for possible rerating per USBC rules. Also a bowler must report if they have been rerated in any tournament in the last 12 months. These disclosures must be made in writing AT LEAST one hour prior to bowling.
9. Bowlers shall be familiar with and abide by USBC Rule 319a (Averages), 319b (Assigned Averages), 319c (re-rating), 319e (Average Adjustment), 322a (Tardy Players) and 328 (Changing Delivery) which will apply to all participants.

## ELIGIBILITY

10. Bowlers must present their USBC memberships card upon check-in. If bowler lost their membership card, they can print a copy on Bowl.com. Bowlers without an USBC card may purchase an Adult Basic (one time membership) for $\$ 10$ which allows them to participate in any event for one weekend. Those paying the adult basic fee are not eligible for USBC Awards.
11. Bowlers must be atleast 18 tears old to participate. Youth bowlers are not permitted to bowl in tourney.
12. Bowlers in the top 25 of the PBA Tour, last year or this year, will not be allowed to participate. Bowlers in the top 10 in the PWBA tour, last year or this year, will not be allowed to participate. Bowlers in the top 10 of the PBA 50+ tour, last year or this year, will not be allowed to participate.
13. Bowlers who arrive after the start time or go over the allotted time will be subject to receive zeroes for frames missed or frames remaining after the allotted time. Bowlers are required to individually check in at each center at least $1 / 2 \mathrm{hr}$ prior to their start time. Team event is allotted 4 hours for their competition. Singles and Doubles events are allotted 4 hours ( 6 bowlers) or 3 hours ( 4 bowlers).
14. The Dutchman Tourn abides by the one Lane Courtesy Rule. All bowlers are asked to abide by this rule, or it could affect their eligibility in future tournaments.

## SUBSTITUTES \& CHANGES

15. All substitutes must fill out a substitution form. This form must be submitted at least one hour prior to the scheduled start time. This applies to team, doubles, and singles. All changes may be emailed, faxed, mailed or made on site. Substitute will assume the original bowlers position.
16. Line-up changes for any event will only be made if requested by the team captain or group leader. All changes must be submitted at least one hour before start time.
17. Tournament management reserves the right to change published lane assignments.
18. EVENTS-Bowlers can only cash in one division in each event

The tournament is divided into events and divisions:
Events
Team - 825 or under; Handicap; Scratch; Ladies
Singles - Handicap; Scratch; Ladies; Recycled Teenagers (55+)
Doubles - Handicap; Scratch; Ladies
Optional Events (Fee required)
Bolony Bank - Handicap; Scratch; Ladies
Optional Singles Team - Handicap; Scratch; Ladies
Optional Singles Doubles - Handicap; Scratch; Ladies
19. Ladies teams do not qualify for $\mathbf{8 2 5}$ Division.

Teams and individuals are entered into both scratch and handicap divisions. Only one prize will be paid per event, that being in the division with the highest money value.
20. Bolony Bank is an optional event using the total of a bowler's singles and doubles events. Bowlers may enter once in this event. If they bowl more than once their first score each event will be used. Entry is optional and is $\$ 10.00$. Bolony Bank entry must be made prior to bowling. Prizes paid at least in 10.
21. Optional Singles Doubles - When bowling the doubles event, the bowler has the opportunity to use that 3 game score for an optional singles event. There will be three divisions; Handicap, Scratch and Ladies. Entry is optional and is $\$ 10.00$. Optional Singles Doubles entry must be made prior to bowling. Prizes paid at least 1 in 10.
22. Optional Singles Team - When bowling the team event, the bowler has the opportunity to use that 4 game score for an optional singles event. There will be three divisions; Handicap, Scratch and Ladies. Entry is optional and is $\$ 10.00$ Optional Singles Team entry must be made prior to bowing. Prizes paid at least 1 in 10 .
23. Recycled Teenager Event (55+ Division) Bowlers age 55 or over are automatically entered into this division provided they provide the tournament with their birth date. There is no additional fee for this division. Failure to report birthday will result in bowler not entered into senior division, but they will still be entered in the other single event divisions.
24. Entrant that bowls singles event, must bowl doubles event or vice versa.

## MISCELLANEOUS

25. Prizes will be paid to at least $\mathbf{1}$ in $\mathbf{7}$ entries except where indicated. Prize fund held in trust for your protection. All prize funds returned $100 \%$. Checks will be mailed to the team captain or squad sponsor.
26. Entry fees must accompany entry form. Entries must be received no later than three weeks prior to bowling. Payment in full must be made no later than two weeks prior to bowling. Penalty for late entries or late fees will be added to the entry fees due. This money will be used for the rush time needed to process the entries or payments. Late fees are $\$ 5$ per person per squad; $\$ 10$ per bowler for the weekend.
27. There will be a $\$ 60.00$ charge for returned checks.
28. On-site transactions will be cash or money order only. No personal checks.
29. PROTEST must be filed in writing to the tournament manager within $\mathbf{2 4}$ hours of completion of match.
