RE-ENTRY

1. **Bowlers may participate up to three times.** Bowlers may cash only once in the singles prize list. Bowlers may cash only one time in the doubles prize list with the same partner but may cash additional times with a change of partner.

AVERAGES and HANDICAPS

2. A **bowler's average is always based on 21 games or more**, averages with less than 21 games will not be considered. Only winter averages are used, unless the bowler only has a summer average. Sport averages only considered if bowler has no other average. Youth league averages will be accepted.

- Entrants use their **highest USBC certified winter average from 2019-20**
- If a **bowler does not have an average from 2019-20**, they can use their **18-19 season average**. If they **do not have a 18-19 average**, they can use their **current ave of 15 games or more**
- If a **bowler's current average**, 21+ games, is **10 or more pins higher than their entering average the higher average will be used**
- If a bowler **doesn't meet any of the above requirements they bowl scratch** (230 ave)
- If a **bowler has a higher average, 21 games or more, in any other competition and it is higher than their entering average, they MUST disclose this to the tournament manager.**

3. **Bowlers are individually responsible for verification of their average**, even if they did not submit their average. Failure of a bowler to report their correct average by the end of the first game, may disqualify their scores. If a bowler's average is found to be higher than the reported average, the scores will be disqualified. If the incorrect average is lower than the actual average, the bowler will use the average reported at the time of bowling, which is the higher average.

4. If a bowler has only a **Sport League** average, their **average will be adjusted using USBC Rules 202a & 202d**.

5. **Handicap based on 90% of 230**. The maximum handicap is 229 pins (145 ave) for men and 297 pins (120 ave) for ladies.

6. **All bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any tournament within the previous 12 month period must report their actual score, position and amount won.** This will be used for possible rerating per USBC rules. Also a bowler must report if they have been rerated in any tournament in the last 12 months. These disclosures must be made in writing AT LEAST one hour prior to bowling.

7. **Bowlers shall be familiar with and abide by USBC Rule 319a (Averages), 319b (Assigned Averages), 319c (re-rating), 319e (Average Adjustment), 322a (Tardy Players) and 328 (Changing Delivery)** which will apply to all participants.

ELIGIBILITY

8. **Bowlers must present their current 20-21 USBC membership card upon check-in.** If bowler lost their membership card, they can print a copy on Bowl.com. Bowlers without an USBC card may purchase an associate membership for \$21.00 and compete in the tournament.

9. Unmarried grade school and high school students who have not attained the age of eighteen must abide by USBC Rule 13.

10. **Entries will not be accepted from PBA members who finished in the top 25 money list the previous year.**

11. **We reserve the right to refuse future entries from;** individuals who do not check in one hour prior to scheduled time and those who do not complete their competition in the allotted time. Singles and Doubles events are allotted three hours with four bowlers on a pair.

12. **The Dutchman Tour abides by the one Lane Courtesy Rule.** Bowlers are asked to abide by this rule, or could affect their eligibility in future tournaments.

SUBSTITUTES & CHANGES

13. **All substitutes must fill out a substitution form.** This form must be submitted at least one hour prior to the scheduled start time. All changes must be emailed, faxed, mailed or made on site. Substitute will assume the original bowlers position.

EVENTS

The tournament is divided into events and divisions:

Singles – Handicap; Scratch; Ladies; Recycled Teenagers (55+)

Doubles – Handicap; Scratch; Ladies

Optional Events (*Fee required*)

Bolony Bank - Handicap; Scratch; Ladies

Optional Singles Doubles – Handicap; Scratch; Ladies

14. **Doubles pairs and individuals are entered into both scratch and handicap divisions. Only one prize will be paid, that being the highest money value.**

15. **Bolony Bank** is an optional event using the total of a bowler's singles and doubles events. Bowlers may enter once in this event. If they bowl twice, their first score in each event will be used. Entry is optional and is \$10.00. Bolony Bank entry must be made prior to bowling.

16. **Optional Singles Doubles - When bowling the doubles event, the bowler has the opportunity to use that 3 game score for an optional singles event.** There will be three divisions; Handicap, Scratch and Ladies. Entry is optional and is \$10.00. Optional Singles Doubles entry must be made prior to bowling.

17. **Recycled Teenager Event (55+ Division)** Bowlers age 55 or over are automatically entered into this division provided they provide the tournament with their birth date. There is no additional fee for this division. Failure to report birthday will result in bowler not entered into senior division, but they will still be entered in the other single event divisions.

18. **Entrants that bowl singles event, must bowl doubles event or vice versa.**

MISCELLANEOUS

19. **Prizes will be paid to at least 1 in 7 entries** except where indicated. Prize fund held in trust for your protection. All prize funds returned 100%. Checks will be mailed to the team captain or squad sponsor.

20. There will be a **\$60.00 charge for returned checks.**

21. **On-site transactions will be cash or money order only. No personal checks.**

22. **PROTEST must be filed in writing to the tournament manager within 24 hours of completion of match**

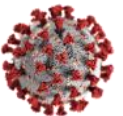

Covid-19 Policies

Per CDC guidelines we ask you follow these procedures



- If a bowler has a fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or has been in contact with a positive covid-19 patient, they are not allowed in the building.
- Masks must be worn in all areas. Masks may be pulled down while on the approach bowling.
- Social distancing should be maintained by all bowlers. There will be extra room for bowlers, as there will only be two bowlers per lane. Minimal spectators will be allowed and we encourage only the bowlers attend. Bowlers should remain in their competition area as much as possible. Children will not be allowed to run around. The game room is closed.
